2. Discussion

- KBØCCL agreed to update repeater's media player video to add content and reflect changes that have occurred at th repeater site, in member shacks, and ac the new animated ID video from NØGL.
- KØPFX expressed need for IP help to ad WØATN streaming to the ATN network (atn-tv.net). Looking for a volunteer. This may be easy to do (ZOOM). It just needs an owner who wi set it up for the club.
- KØPFX provided spec info for a possible replacement of the existing Diamond XI with a Challenger 1150/1151 series Vertical (426.000 Transmit located on the side and below the Receiver antenna.)
- Browser on Linux "NASA" content PC needs updating to a newer version. Looking for a volunteer.
- KØPFX will rearrange equipment in rack 2022 to reflect the larger amplifier installed in 2021.
- Membership unanimously agreed to change weekly nets from morning Wed 10AM to evening Wed 7PM.
- KØPFX called on membership to look fo way to add and show new content vided for our nets in 2022
- SLATS will have presence again at Winterfest '22. KØPFX asked members volunteer some time at the booth.



- NØGL provided a presentation showing the features of SLATS web site and how to navigate and use them. NØGL called on membership to use the "For Sale" section for selling/buying/trading your ham radio gear.
- KBØCCL requested the possibility of a "Members only" page. NØGL said he would look into it and report later.
- KØPFX described the 146.73 and 443.450 FM (WØKE) repeaters with pictures and words and now available for SLATS transfer of ownership. Present SLATS members voted unanimously to take ownership of the repeaters.
- KØPFX will provide the change in the repeater's IDs and addition of a jumper at the 146.73 antenna to repair a kinked 7/8th hardline. A letter to Missouri Repeater Council will be sent requesting change in club ownership from NWAR/EA to SLATS for retaining coordination. NØMFC was made a member of SLATS and agreed to continue as Trustee for the foreseeable future.
- KØPFX suggested a weekly net on 146.73 and asked membership to consider this and help find a volunteer for NCS.
- Meeting was adjourned ~1:15pm with members agreeing food was good and service excellent and to continue future in-person meetings at the Sport Café. Thanks to WØNZG for volunteering to take the minutes.

Winterfest 2022 °

Winterfest hamfest. SLATS was there with 2 stations demonstrating DATV with live video between KØPFX and NØGL. The SLATS sign was proudly shown and biz cards were available for booth visitors. Several visitors expressed interest in DATV so we hope they will join with us soon.

Our SLATS president, Mel Whitten - KØPFX, was a guest speaker from 11:00-11:45 a.m. talking about FreeDV -Digital Voice Over HF.



Bio: Mel (KØPFX) is an early adopter of Digital Voice over HF putting together a team of alpha testers back in 2012 to provide feedback on the usability and design of a new free and open source HF digital voice program he named FreeDV. On its tenth anniversary, FreeDV has evolved into many improvements through innovation by its authors and feedback from its users. Mel has been a long-time presenter at many hamfests across the country and ARRL/TAPR Digital Communications
Conferences. He is a retired telecom engineer spending his last 12 years as a consultant in the industry.
