

POWER SUPPLY BARGIN

Newark has DC power supply on sale for half price. Made by Tenma. Same brand that I have been using for long time with my ATV station builds. This one is smaller and the manual says it is good for 15Amp continuous so should be good for ATV 10w amplifier's ~8amps. It's a switcher as are the others I continue to use on ATV with no noise or harmonic problems. I used my electronic load (PS tester) and set it for 14 amps at 13.6. This is about 190w. I had it under this load about ten minutes. Supply has a small fan in rear and it came on about 5 minutes into the test. It shut down in about 4 minutes completely after removing the load.

"Analog" audio from your HiDes Digital Receiver?

IN a recent QSO with Armand KDØPXF and John WØNZG, the CVBS-Composite Video Blanking and Sync (AV-OUT) connector on the rear of your HI DES receiver was topic for a discussion. From the Quick Start Guide (QSG), John read that "Both HDMI and AV-OUT (audio) output are supported simultaneously, but the mechanical design allows only one to be connected. "The mechanical restriction is correct, but only for the HV -110 design. HIDes fixed this problem in the later HV-120 models. Armand pointed out that the AV -OUT connector would also provide audio with the HDMI audio. I wasn't sure if both audio sources would be available at same time. So, I used the AV cable shipped with my HV-120 receiver and connected the L (white) and R (red) RCA connectors to my amplified JBL speaker. Note: Depending on the speaker(s) connected, a standard stereo 1/8th inch TRS (tip-ring-sleeve) plug into the AV-OUT's TRSS (tip-ring-ring-sleeve) socket may be used. For this audio-only application, the second "ring" connection on the AV-OUT is Video out and its signal is OFF. Avoid using a mono TS pluq!


I then got on the air and received video with sound and Bam! The audio was available at the same time with the embedded HDMI's audio. Voices sounded very good! Level was adjusted using the remote. So, why would you want to do this when HDMI sound is available? With an external "high fidelity" powered speaker, you should find the audio sounds much better than from your laptop's speakers or from those internal tinny speakers in most TV sets. In the past, I have experienced loss of sync for the audio even when the video did not. This "analog" connection might avoid that problem. Or maybe you will find another use for having a second audio output available. Either way, it's a handy audio source to have.
