Television's 100th Anniversary?

Yes, it has been about that long since Television was "invented." There were earlier demonstrations but technically the first one was October 2, 1925. It was on this date that John Logie Baird (UK) saw the "recognizable features of the head of a ventriloquist dummy, Stooky Bill," at 22 Fifth St. in London's Soho district." But this was only a private demo of mechanical television system.

Two years earlier on June 14, 1923 in Washington DC, Charles Jenkins demonstrated live motion wireless images but they were only silhouettes. And before this, a name you may recognize, Reginald Fessenden (recall he claimed to make the first radio broadcast of speech and music in 1906) filed a patent describing "early workings" of TV in 1922. Fessenden may have actually been the first to invent TV because of his documented work on light valve's construction, however he liked to "blow his own horn" so there has been some doubt about his claims.

Logie Baird's first public demonstration of television was later given in 1926. A year later Philo T. Farnsworth here in the US introduced the electronic version of television by transmitting a straight white line. I would give the most credit to Farnsworth since he demonstrated more like what I would recognize as *real* TV.

Digital terrestrial TV in the US came many years later (June 2009) while DVB-T became popular in the early 2000s in the UK. I have written about ATSC 3.0 or "Next Gen TV" in earlier newsletters. It continues to gain popularity but it will probably be in the 2030s before ATSC1.0 is fully replaced.
